Newspapers, magazines, brochures & inserts (no plastic bags, do not tie & bundle)



Cartons

Corrugated cardboard & Paper bags (flattened)



Greeting cards, regular & junk mail



Cardboard beverage carriers



Paperboard boxes (cereal, pasta & tissue)

- Plastic bags

- Plastic microwave trays
- Window panes, mirrors, ceramics & Pyrex dishware
- Plastics other than those listed
- Paint, pesticides, oil & cleansers
- Stickers or address label sheet waste
- Waxed paper or waxed cardboard
- Styrofoam or paper to-go containers
- Organic material and food waste
- Electronic waste (batteries, cell phones, computers, etc.)

1st & 3rd Monday!

NO NEED TO REMOVE:

Paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, metal fasteners, cellophane address windows, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs

Please flatten all cardboard boxes. Empty and rinse all containers.

Recyclables must be placed in a reusable container no larger than 32-45 gallons with a **SECURE** lid.

Recyclables are **NOT** to be placed in plastic bags!

Please follow these guidelines carefully.

Put out Sunday Night!

Recycling Pickup is available for all residential dwellings located on roads regularly serviced by garbage haulers on the **FIRST** and **THIRD MONDAY** of each month. Material must be placed at the curbside the **Sunday evening** before scheduled pick-up. The contracted hauler starts before 5 AM. Please place recyclables out for the scheduled day regardless of any holidays.
